Search for a Commodity Code

To determine the correct commodity code and rates of duty applicable to your goods, you'll need details of the product you're importing or exporting. This could include:

- The type of product
- What the product is used for
- The materials used to make it
- How it was produced
- The way it is packaged

The eTariff tool will also help you check the following:

- Legal notes that outline the particular commodity code requirements and which can guide in tariff classification
- Preferential rates of duty which may be applicable depending on specific Trade Agreements

Additionally, the HS code may be subject to additional duties, such as:

- Anti-dumping duties
- Safeguarding measures

International Classification Harmonised System (HS) vs SACU Common External Tariff (CET)

The Harmonised System (HS) is an international product nomenclature developed by the World Customs Organization (WCO). It comprises more than 5,000 commodity groups, each of which are identified by a 6-digit code, arranged in a legal and logical structure.

The system is used by more than 200 countries and economies as a basis for their Customs tariffs and for the collection of international trade statistics. In Namibia, tariff classification is based on the SACU CET, where the HS code is declared at 8 digits.



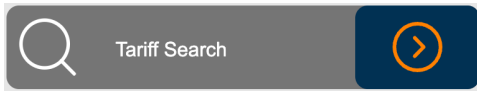
Use the eTariff tool to assist with the tariff classification process, or obtain expert assistance with classification, to ensure that you pay the correct duties and taxes.

The tariff browse enables searching through all sections of the Harmonized System (HS). The HS Code (Harmonized System Code) is a classification or commodity code used by customs authorities around the world to identify goods for global trade.

The Harmonized System consists of 21 Sections, which are broken down into broad categories of goods. Each section comprises of one or more chapters.

The first two digits of the HS code identify the chapter into which the goods are grouped, while headings and sub-headings are denoted by four-digit and six-digit codes.



Chapter 01	Live animals
Chapter 02	Meat and edible meat offal
Chapter 03	Fish and crustaceans, molluscs and other aquatic invertebrates
Chapter 04	Dairy produce; birds eggs; natural honey; edible products of animal origin, not elsewhere specified or included
Chapter 05	Products of animal origin, not elsewhere specified or included

Chapter 06	Live trees and other plants; bulbs, roots and the like; cut flowers and ornamental foliage

The Electronic Advance Rulings menu option will allow users to search for approved rulings relating to tariff classification, origin determination and valuation.


Advance Rulings are an important Trade Facilitation tool, creating certainty and predictability in the trade transaction. NamRA's Advance Rulings programme has been operational since 2022, and with the launch of the eTariff Tool will now be available online.


Traders may apply for an Advance Ruling by registering a profile and using the online application form. The process is transparent, with Traders being kept informed about the status of their application from submission to approval.
